In the practice of psychology, we frequently encounter dilemmas that have clinical, ethical, and legal elements. The focus of this workshop will be on case vignettes that highlight these types of situations and how they might be resolved.

### **By the end of this workshop participants will:**

1. describe some of the philosophical underpinnings of ethics codes and the notion of professional self-regulation;
2. identify applicable sources of guidance for the ethical and legal practice of psychology in training clinics;
3. describe a model of ethical decision making;
4. apply an ethical decision making model to common ethical dilemmas in training clinics; and
5. describe common considerations in ethical decision making including the identification of competing obligations and the application of judgment rules vs. absolute ethical or legal duties.

**Instructional Level:** Intermediate

**Educational Format:** Lecture, vignettes, question and answer
